Welcome to the 9th edition of the RightPath newsletter.

Study recruitment to the RightPath evaluation has now ended in Oldham and the last patient has attended their RightPath consultation. The RightPath service has now been commissioned here and the triage service and dedicated clinics will continue to be provided.

Work will now focus at the South Tyneside site.

Here the local existing pathway is such that we are unable to deliver the triage intervention as originally planned.

Instead data will be collected in accordance with the protocol for direct referrals to physiotherapy and podiatry eligible for RightPath.

For the patients that are referred by the GP direct to paediatric, rather than implementing the triage intervention, we will aim to ascertain the number of patients who would be eligible for RightPath and inform future planning of the local referral process.

The first clinic day planned for recruitment at South Tyneside is 29th June 2017.


