

This is a sample referral letter to be used in sessions for the triage team to inform case based discussions and practice use of the triage and referral guidance. We suggest that these are used in group activities with a facilitator who has experience of paediatric musculoskeletal clinical practice.

I would be grateful if you would see this 7-year old girl who is flat footed, so slightly in toeing but marginal more on the left. Over pronated on both with no arch when stood. Mum noticed more recently on left; typical wear of shoes.

On examination: PROM – hip/knee and ankle, non-tender, no swelling, equal ROM, back – NAD. No history of trauma, no congenital issues, normal development and no subtalar issues, inversion/eversion – normal.

I would appreciate your help with further management.

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
